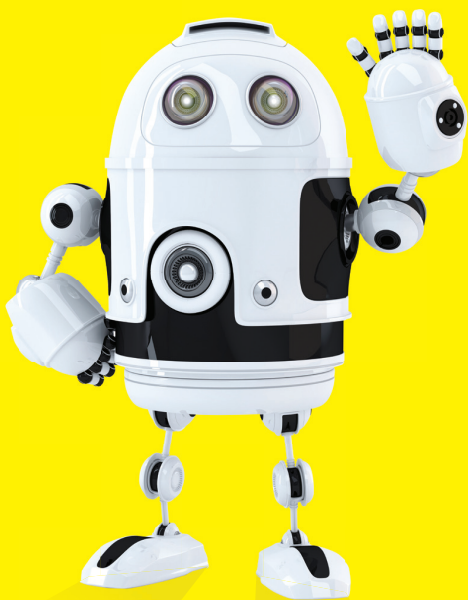

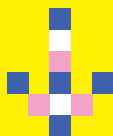

STEP 1

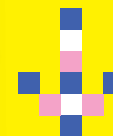


Register your school.

School registrations open 28 January 2020 and close 3 July 2020. The Challenge is open to all year levels. Register at commissionersdigitalchallenge.net.au/register



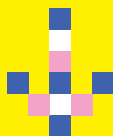
STEP 4

Don't know where to start? Take a look at our recommended Challenge activities for beginners. It's recommended that students complete all activities by 11 September 2020.

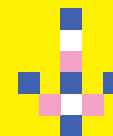
STEP 2



Spread the word.
